Every December ASHA collects food for destitute asylum seekers and to support individuals whose income is £35.39 a week for food, toiletries, clothing and travel.

Most wanted items are:

Basmati rice, Sunflower cooking oil, Long life milk, Sugar, Tinned Tomatoes and Tuna, Pasta, Cereals, S/R & maize flour, Couscous, Chick peas, Biscuits, Jam, Honey, Coffee, Salt and Pepper
No packet soup or tinned meat, thank you.

ASHA collects good quality **CLOTHING** for asylum seekers and **SHOES** and **OLD COTHING** to be sold for recycling and the proceeds used to the buy food in short supply.
